An Accountable Care Organization is:

- ❖ Groups of doctors, hospitals, and other **health care providers**
- ❖ Focused on **improving quality of care** and **health outcomes**, thereby decreasing cost
- ❖ Focus on **preventive medicine**
- ❖ Ensure that patients and populations — especially the chronically ill — get the **right care**, at the **right time** and without harm.
- ❖ Avoid care that has no proven benefit or represents an unnecessary duplication of services



Medicare Shared Savings Program

Program that rewards ACOs who meet performance standards on quality of care, put their patients first, and decrease their health care costs.
